What issues do you see that this plan should address?

Language barriers to access medical transportation (ex. bus is difficult, call to schedule transportation, driver) +2

Safety (ex. Gettysburg Ave) +2

Network of bike lanes needed to connect neighborhoods and destinations around city (issue with riding on sidewalks)

Medical transportation not reliable (ex. late, inconsistent, flexibility) +2

Safe mid-block crosswalks on busy roads, especially where there are destinations across the street (ex. families, children crossing road) +2

Safe routes to schools, parks, grocery etc. (sidewalks, crosswalks, trip hazards)

Food desert - Grocery stores in walking distance to residents

Pedestrian bridges where there would be a lot of delay at signalized intersection

Snow removal (sidewalks, crosswalks)

Lighting (ex. bike paths and sidewalks to schools, parks and bus stops)

Need safe and obvious routes to community health resources (ex. Issue with buses in bike lane, bike lane marking not visible)
