

BRIDGE TO BAY TRAIL KIOSKS

What will it cost?

The cost of the kiosk structure and panels will be covered by a grant from the Community Foundation of St. Clair County. The cost for the installation, order assistance and any custom artwork is the responsibility of the local units of government.

Who will assemble the Kiosk?

The assembly is the responsibility of the local unit of government.

Who will install the Footings?

The local unit of government. Terrabilt provides an engineered footing design, the "L" anchor bolts and bolt template in advance of the kiosk kit after the order is confirmed. A local engineer should review depth to accommodate frost level. The Double Post Outboard Kiosk may be ordered for direct embedment or base plate mount for use on a concrete pad .

Who will install the concrete pad?

The local unit of government. Please adjust the pad size accordingly if there are graphics on both sides of the kiosks.

Are any permits required?

Check with your local municipality to see if any permits are required for construction.

What would you like to do with the backside of the kiosk?

Options include:

1. Keep the back side of the kiosk blank
2. Duplicate the front side on the back
3. Provide customized local information, including options for encased bulletin boards and brochure holders (see following pages for more details)

The local unit of government is responsible for any custom art work used on the back panel or inset map on the front of the kiosk.

What will it cost to add custom artwork?

Custom art work bills out at around \$100/hr. Formating and customizing an existing trail town or bike ride map from the website will cost around \$500. Expect to pay at least double that for any new artwork, such as a park map.

- Large Roofed Sign
- 48" Tall x 36" Wide Modular Display Areas
- Single or Double Sided
- Requires Footing
- Provide a 15' x 6' concrete pad in front of sign. If the sign is two-sided a 16' x 10' concrete pad should be installed so both sides of the sign are wheelchair accessible.
- The panel includes an overview map of the trail with areas for customized information on the local community, including options for encased bulletin boards and a brochure holder.

\$7,000 - 8,000

Installation, concrete pad, and development of custom graphics are additional costs.

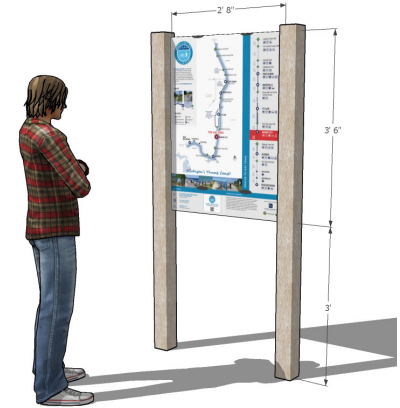
- Smaller Roofed Sign
- 32" Tall x 36" Wide Modular Display Areas
- Single or Double Sided
- Requires Footing
- Provide a 5' x 5' concrete pad in front of sign. If sign is two-sided, turn perpendicular to pathway and a 10' x 12' concrete pad should be installed so both sides of the sign are wheelchair accessible.
- This kiosk includes an overview map of the trail on the front panel. There is an option to provide customized local information on the back side of the panel.

\$6,000 - 7,000

Installation, concrete pad, and development of custom graphics are additional costs.

Terrabilt Double Post Outboard

Smaller and No Roof



- Simple Two Post Sign
- 32" Wide x 36" Tall Modular Display Area
- Single or Double Sided
- Direct Embedment or Surface Mount
- Provide a 5' x 5' concrete pad in front of sign. If sign is two-sided, turn perpendicular to pathway and a 10' x 12' concrete pad should be installed so both sides of the sign are wheelchair accessible.
- This kiosk includes an overview map of the trail on the front panel. There is an option to provide customized local information on the back side of the panel.

\$2,000 - 3,000

Installation, concrete pad, and development of custom graphics are additional costs.

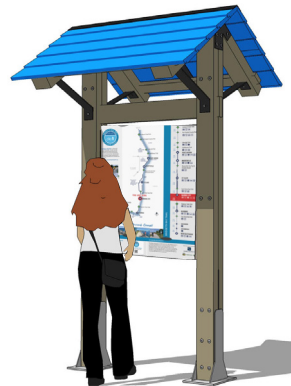

Direct embedment or baseplate mount of posts and a 5' x 5' concrete pad in front of sign. If sign is two-sided, turn perpendicular to pathway and a 10' x 12' concrete pad should be installed so both sides of the sign are wheelchair accessible.

3. Panel Material - All products are rigid and 1/8" thick substrates. Vinyl on aluminum is the least resistant to vandalism but may be a good solution when changing information over a shorter period of time.

4. Laminate Coating - The laminate coating provides protection against UV and graffiti. A matte finish will be less reflective and easier to read in an outdoor application.

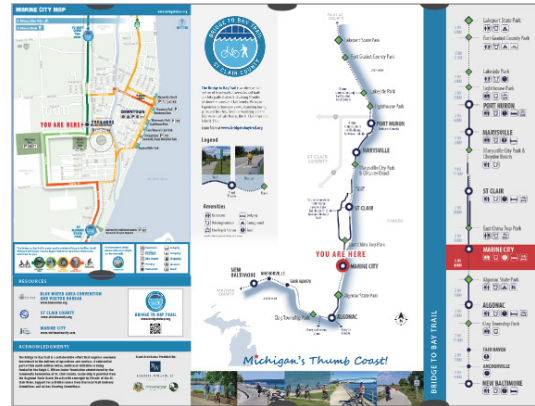
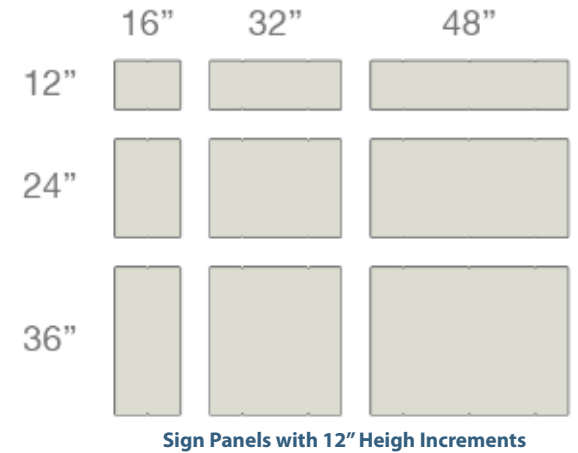
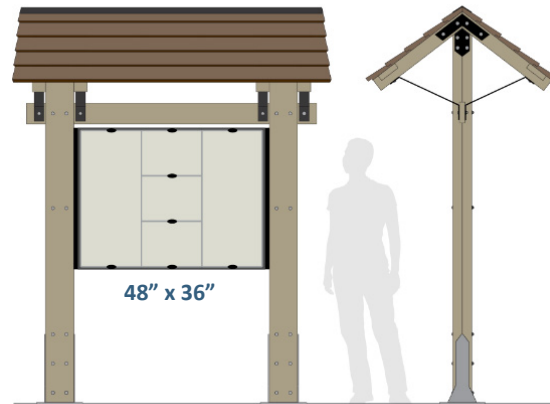
Terrabilt 2-Post Mini Kiosk

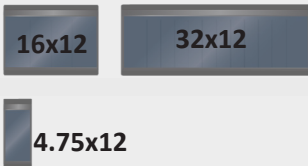

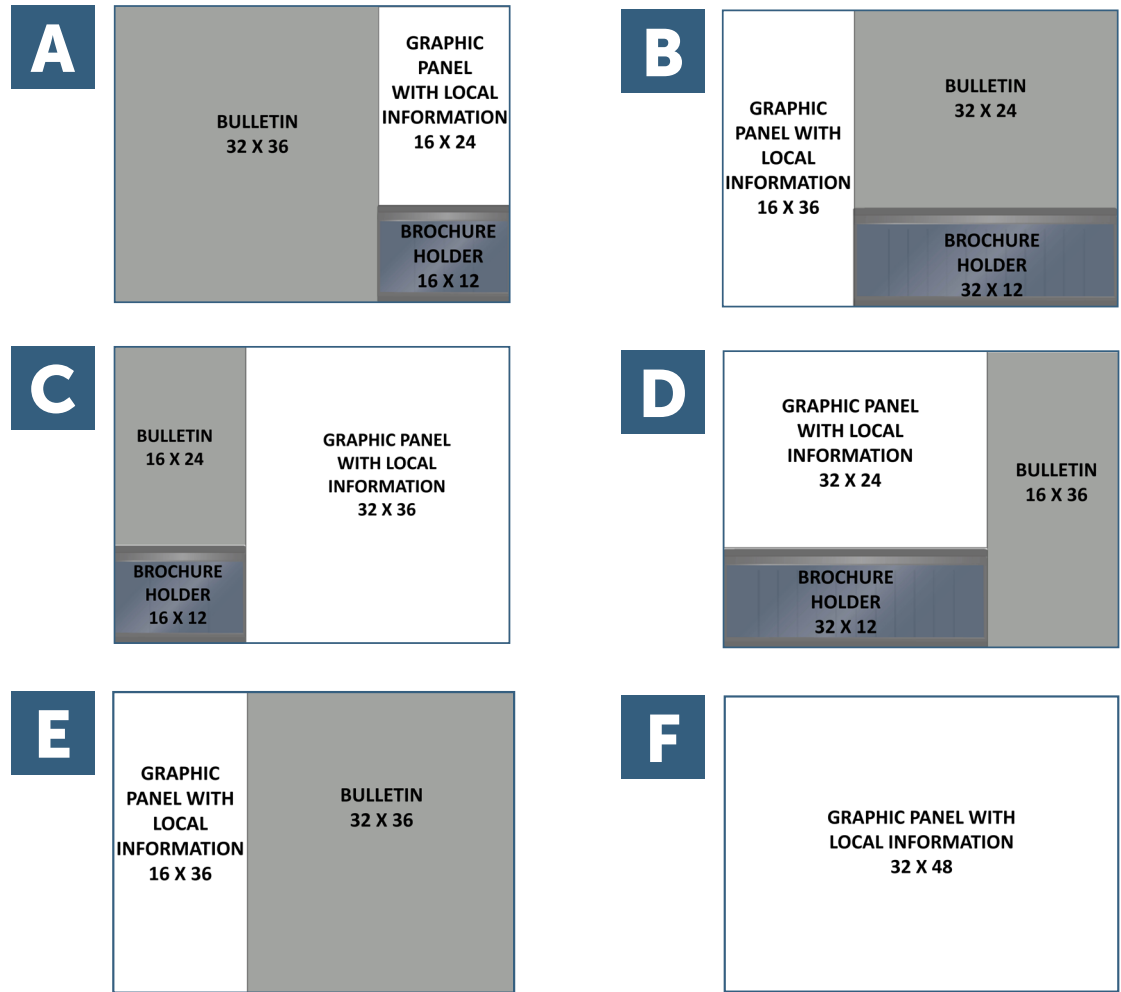

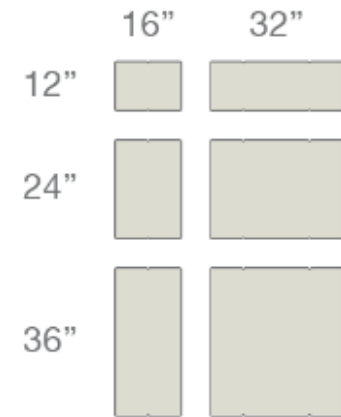
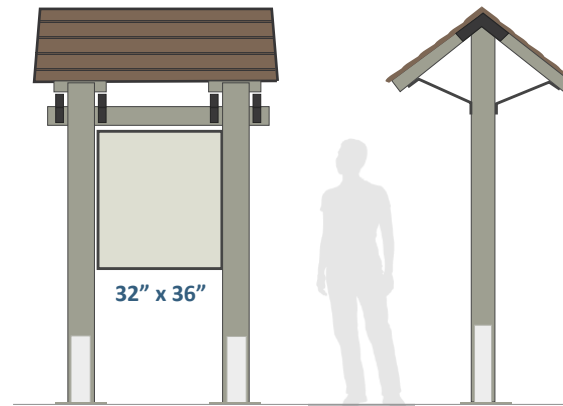
Terrabilt Trailhead Kiosk

- Accepts modular panels for 16" and 32" widths and 12", 24, and 36" mounting heights
- Postings include graphic panels, tack board, and a sheer profile bulletin case.

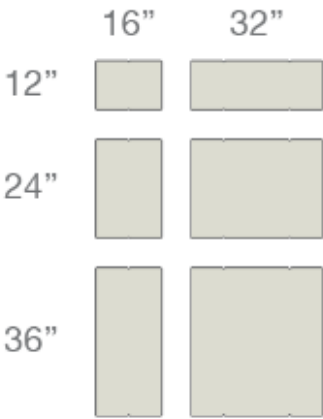
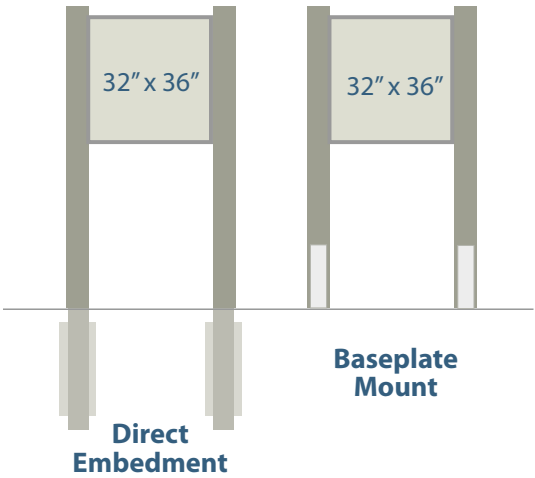
Terrabilt Double Post Outboard

Smaller with No Roof

Features:

- Double sided mounting uses common receiver panel: same size on both sides.
- Fused image graphic panels (FIA) are printed on both sides for ease of upgrade if damaged.
- Retroreflective panels (TRR) are imaged on one side only.
- Accepts modular panels for 16", 32" and 48" widths and 12", 24", and 36" mounting heights
- Standard posts are 3.5" x 3.5" (4" x 4" nominal), 4.5" x 4.5" (5" x 5" nominal) and 5.5" x 5.5" (6" x 6" nominal) depending on desired look or size of assembly.

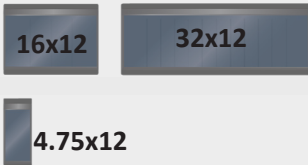
