

- It is an iterative process


We Are Not Starting From Scratch

Lots of progress since City of Novi Non-motorized Master Plan in 2011

- Novi ITC Trail
- M-5 Metro Trail
- Connections to the I-275 Trail

City of Novi Biannual Non-motorized Prioritization

 Identifies and completes missing sidewalks and pathway segments






Planning for people who walk, bike and ride



- About moving people not objects
- Focus on the safety of the most vulnerable roadways users, pedestrians and bicyclists
- Let everyone travel independently and with dignity
- Recognize that streets impact a community's neighborhood, culture, commerce and environment


Project Timeline



• This is our first round of community input


Existing System and Plan Evaluation

- Comprehensive inventory and analysis
- Support data-driven recommendation
- Composite analysis that focuses on equity, safety, and demand




The Pedestrian Network

- Some neighborhoods have sidewalks
- Some mobile home communities are missing sidewalk connections
- Gaps along major roads
- Existing crosswalk spacing is too far apart, people will not go that far out of their way to cross a road when there is demand
- High speeds and traffic volumes make it difficult to cross the road




The Bikeway Network

- Novi's bicycle facilities primarily consist of pathways along the major roads
- Bike lanes on S Lake Dr only in one direction
- Neighborhood roads can provide low stress bicycle routes across the city
- Improve connections to Lakeshore Park
- May be opportunities to connect Novi's ITC Trail to the regional trail network, parks and amenities




Regional Connections

- Downtown Northville and Maybury State Park
- Lyon Oaks and Lakeshore Park
- Opportunity for 30-mile regional trail loop through Novi
- Link into the Statewide Trail system: Great Lake-to-Lake Trail and Iron Belle Trail

- Destination in Novi
 - ITC Trail
 - Lakeshore Park
 - Retail centers
- Adjacent Destinations
 - Maybury State Park and Downtown Northville
 - Lyon Oaks County Park
 - Regional trails
 - Transit


