Meeting Notes:

- Macatawa Trail: Designate as Active Planning.
- **Regional Parks:** Ottawa County offered to provide information on other regionally significant parks. Follow up with Aaron.
- Fred Meijer Kenowa Trail: Efforts ongoing to close the gap through Byron Township.
- Muskegon Area New Trail Developments: Trails planned between Muskegon Heights and Dune Harbor, and Duck Lake to Muskegon State Park.
- Idema Explorers Trail: Update to include recent construction. Follow up with Aaron on alignment.
- Grand River Greenway: Routing update required. Follow up with Ben on trail routing plan.



- Add Conceptual Railroad Connection in Grand Rapids Proposed addition between Grand River and Ada following railroad. It has been turned down in the past, but worth keeping in for future opportunities.
- Side Path Upgrades: Request for recommended cross-sections for upgrading existing side paths, such as Lakeshore Drive, to align with current best practices. Emphasized the potential appeal of urban trails if designed effectively, citing Joe Louis Greenway as an example.
- Redundancy of Trails: Discussion on the value of the loop between Grand Rapids and Grand Haven, despite existing redundancy. Highlighted the need for additional bridges to connect the north and south sides of the river.
- Norton Shores Development: Norton Shores is progressing with the connection between Grand Haven and Muskegon.
- **Desire for Information Sharing:** Participants expressed interest in convening a larger meeting to share best practices, including topics such as e-bikes and trail regulations.
- Meeting Materials: PowerPoint and recording to be distributed to participants.








How Would You Prioritize Spending Trail Dollars?
